CORPS DE BALLETT (IRE), **won** two races (5f. - 6f.) at two and three years and £12,574 and placed three times.

Dam of **one winner**, 1 runner, 2 previous foals:

DARK LANE (GB) (2006 c. by Namid (GB)), **won** two races at two and three years, 2009 and £31,650 and placed three, from only 7 starts.

Compton Park (GB) (2007 c. by Compton Place (GB)), unraced.

2nd Dam

Dwell (USA), **won** one race at three years and £20,059 and placed four times including third in Remembrance Day EBF Stakes, Doncaster, **L**.

Dam of **eight winners**, 10 runners, 10 foals including:

QUICK ACTION (IRE), Champion sprinter in Hong Kong in 1996-97, **won** eight races at three to six years and £750,927 in Hong Kong including Chairman's Prize, Sha Tin, **L**, and The Centenary Cup, Sha Tin, **L**, and placed eighteen times.

DOOWALEY (IRE), **won** seven races at three to five years and £100,073 in Italy including Premio W. W. F., Rome, **L**, and placed ten times including third in Miami Mile Breeders' Cup Handicap, Calder, **Gr.3**.
